- GBU identifies a branding agency to assist it with development of a better presence on the internet (e.g. website, social media etc.). GBU to create marketing materials with input from UoE to support student recruitment (Admission) activity.
- GBU carry out agreed research with support of UoE and develop a report. GBU DG, Director, Dean and Registrar endorse the findings and recommendations of the joint report and communicate this to the GBU faculty and Professional Services in writing.
- UoE and GBU co-design specific entrance exam for international students (based around previous synoptic exams) to verify candidate academic suitability for academic style and rigour of GBU curriculum 2024-25.
