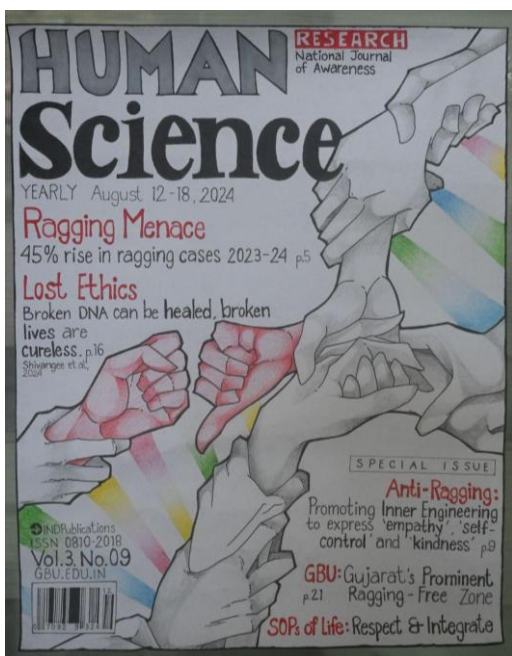
Ek Ped maa ke Naam – 5th September 2024
